DUTIES: Under the direct supervision of the Chief Engineer, the Electrician I is responsible for installing transmission lines for electrical equipment, assemble, install and repair electric lights, motors, heaters, generators, transformers, and other electrical apparatus. Troubleshoot electrical systems, operate electrical power generating plants, maintain and electric shop, operate electrical equipment, advise in the selection and storage of electrical equipment, consult and work with other Trades people, make rough sketches and estimate the cost of minor electrical installations, Assist the Stationary Engineers with electrical work in the boiler room, chiller plant and equipment rooms, main kitchen equipment, Assist with testing, troubleshooting and repair of campus fire alarm system, keep simple records and make reports.

DESIRED QUALIFICATIONS: Highly motivated and a self-starter, good organizational skills, mechanical ability, computer skills working with programs such as Microsoft word, outlook, and excel. Good diagnostic and troubleshooting ability.
