This position involves working with a team of school counselors to provide direct personal counseling services to students in individual, group, and conjoint family sessions; provide crisis intervention services to students; make presentations to students in classroom settings; consult with teachers, administrators, and residential staff; attend Counseling Department staff meetings, IEP meetings, and interdisciplinary instructional department meetings; interact with community agencies.

- Possession of or eligible for California Pupil Personnel Services (PPS) Credential as a School Counselor
