Work Schedule

This position is employed 194 working days per school year. The traditional school calendar extends from early August through mid-June.

General Duties

Responsibilities of this position can be met by qualified applicants who hold the appropriate credentials in Speech-Language Pathology. The position involves working as part of a team to help students develop skills in the areas of listening, speaking, and speechreading to support the development of reading and writing skills. Duties include assessment of students, report writing, preparing IEP's, implementing speech therapy programs, assessing and documenting progress on speech goals, and maintaining clinical notes. Duties also include consultation with other staff members and parents as needed to facilitate development of spoken communication skills and literacy.

Required Qualifications

- Master's Degree in Speech Language Pathology (or equivalent degree)
- Demonstrate interest in helping deaf and hard-of-hearing (D/HH) students utilize spoken communication skills to support literacy.
- Ability to work as part of a team to design and implement a coordinated speech program for D/HH students from age 18 months through High School.
- Ability to communicate with others in a personable and professional manner.
- Possession of, or eligibility for, the California Clinical or Rehabilitative Services Credential, or Speech-Language Pathology Services Credential.
- Required to attend ASL classes if needed.

Desirable Qualifications

- Experience working with D/HH children
- Experience or interest in using technology to support development of spoken communication skills.
- Knowledge and ability to communicate in ASL.
