2026-2027 School Year - High School Academic Bowl Assistant Coach

Job Description

California School for the Deaf – Riverside (CSDR) seeks applicants for Assistant Coach of the high school Academic Bowl team.

Responsible for supporting the Head Coach in the leadership, supervision, and development of the program. Duties include, but are not limited to:

- Assisting the Head Coach in planning and running practice sessions to prepare students for academic competitions.
- Supporting recruitment and encouraging student participation in the Academic Bowl program.
- Assisting with team registration, travel, and scheduling for matches and tournaments.
- Monitoring students' academic eligibility and progress.
- Supporting the Head Coach in promoting the program by providing prompt and accurate reporting of results to the High School Department and local/social media.
- Assisting the Head Coach in supervising and mentoring student participants, and assuming Head Coach responsibilities in their absence, as needed.
- Carrying out assignments and tasks as directed by the Head Coach and/or the High School Department.

Qualifications

- Dedication to the academic and personal development of students is desired.
- Prior coaching, teaching, or quiz bowl/academic competition experience preferred.
- Applicant must possess current cardiopulmonary resuscitation (CPR)/First Aid certification.
- Fluency in American Sign Language (ASL) is required.

Period of Tenure

- August 2026 – June 2027 (Full School Year)

Coaching Differential

- Academic Bowl Assistant Coach – \$2,750.

Who May Apply

The position is an extra assignment for exempt teaching staff at CSDR. Civil service employees are eligible to apply for the position. Supervisor approval is required.

When submitting a letter of interest, please include reasons for your interest and your background/experience. Letters of interest will be screened based on the identified desirable qualifications and only the most qualified may be scheduled for an interview.
