### **Job Description**

California School for the Deaf – Riverside (CSDR), a member of California Interscholastic Federation – Southern Section (CIF-SS) seeks applicants for Head Coach in high school Track.

**Full responsibilities on the overall supervision and development of the program, which include, but are not limited to:**

- Handling game and practice assignments,
- Assist with weekly monitoring of student-athletes' academic progress, and assist with dorm and travel arrangement,
- Assist in promoting the sport by prompt, accurate reporting of statistics and scores to the Athletic Department and local/social media.
- Work on assignments as requested by the Athletic Director.

### **Qualifications**

- Knowledge and adherence to compliance with National Federation of State High School Associations (NFHS), CIF-SS and school rules and dedication to the academic and athletic development of student-athletes are desired.
- Applicants must possess current cardiopulmonary resuscitation (CPR)/First Aid and CIF/NFHS coaching certificates.
- Fluency in American Sign Language (ASL) is required.
