Work Schedule

This position is employed 184 working days per school year. The traditional school calendar extends from early August through mid-June.

General Duties

This position involves working with a team of school counselors to provide direct personal counseling services to students in individual, group, and conjoint family sessions; provide crisis intervention services to students; give preventive education/SEL presentations to students in classroom settings; consult with teachers, administrators, and residential staff; attend Counseling Department staff meetings, IEP meetings, and interdisciplinary instructional department meetings; interact/**collaborate** with community agencies.

Required Qualifications

- Possession of a Master's Degree in School Counseling or Clinical Mental Health Counseling
- Possession of, or eligible for, California Pupil Personnel Services (PPS) Credential as a School Counselor
- Qualified applicants who meet State of California PPS Credential Requirements at the time of hire will be given up to one year to provide a copy of a valid credential.
- Passage of CBEST or equivalent to meeting the Basic Skills Requirements per the California Commission on Teacher Credentialing. CBEST or Basic Skills Requirement must be met within one year from issuance of credential.
- Proficiency in American Sign Language.
