Work Schedule

This position is employed 184 working days per school year. The traditional school calendar extends from August through early June.

General Duties

Implement individualized Education Plans that meet the educational needs of the DHH students on assigned caseload in accordance with State and Federal policies, regulations and standards. Provide lessons which meet the needs of all students, behavior through effective functional behavior assessments, positive support plans, and classroom environment controls; use instructional time effectively. Effectively plan and prepare lessons that utilize a variety of methodologies and techniques that meet the needs of all students and facilitate mastery of IEP goals and objectives. Administer, score, and interpret informal educational assessment procedures/instruments designed for DHH students.

Required Qualifications

- Fluency in expressive and receptive American Sign Language (ASL) of at least a Level 4 ASLPI is required (evaluated through interview process)
- Fluent communication in standard written English
- Possession of a bachelor's degree (BA/BS)
- Passage of the CBEST
- Possess, or be eligible to apply for, a California Education Specialist Instruction Credential with a specialization in Deaf and Hard of Hearing (DHH)
And valid California credential(s) authorizing service for the position in which employed.

NOTE – a bachelor's degree may be either a Bachelor of Arts or a Bachelor of Science. Credentials must be approved by the California Commission on Teacher Credentialing. Qualified applicants who do not meet the credential requirements at the time of hire, may be given up to one year to obtain their credential(s).
