Work Schedule

This position is employed 194 working days per school year. The traditional school calendar extends from early August through mid-June.

General Duties

Responsibilities of this position can be met by qualified applicants who hold the appropriate credentials in Speech-Language Pathology. The position involves working as part of a team to help students meet goals in the areas of language, listening, speaking, and speechreading to support the development of functional communication, reading and writing skills. Duties include assessment of students, report writing, preparing IEP's, implementing speech therapy programs, assessing, and documenting progress on speech goals, and maintaining clinical notes. Duties also include consultation with other staff members and parents as needed to facilitate development of spoken communication skills, functional language skills, and literacy.

Required Qualifications

- Master's Degree in Communication Sciences (or equivalent degree)
- Passage of CBEST or equivalent to meeting the Basic Skills Requirements per the California Commission on Teacher Credentialing. For more information see the California Commission on Teacher Credentialing website at: <http://www.ctc.ca.gov> CBEST or Basic Skills Requirements must be met within one year from issuance of credential.
- Demonstrate interest in helping Deaf and Hard-of-Hearing (D/HH) students learn spoken communication skills and/or functional language skills to support literacy, social interaction, and access to the curriculum
- Ability to work as part of a team to design and implement a coordinated speech program for ECE/ Elementary D/HH students
- Ability to communicate with others in a personable and professional manner
- Possession of, or eligibility for, the California Speech-Language Pathology Services Credential or California Clinical or Rehabilitative Services Credential
- ASL Fluency or strong Basic Interpersonal Communication ASL skills (BICS) to be able to effectively communicate with students and staff

Desirable Qualifications

- Experience in working with D/HH children of all ages
- Experience or interest in using technology to support development of spoken English and functional communication skills (AAC)
- Willingness to improve ASL skills if not fluent (for those at the BICS level)
- Possession of, or working toward ASHA Certificate of Clinical Competence (CFY Supervision available)
